

THE BARREN ISLAND NUISANCE.

Bill to Prohibit Bone-Bolling and the Cremation of Garbage.

ALBANY, Jan. 30.—Senator Wagner of Kings to-night introduced a bill extending the act forbidding bone boiling or garbage cremating in Manhattan to the Borough of Brooklyn. The bill is aimed particularly at the Barren Island nuisance. He says in relation to the bill:

“ This bill is introduced to remedy the suffering of a great number of residents whose health was not alone impaired, but who also suffered financially on account of not being able to let their buildings or cottages because of the stenches coming from Barren Island. We have formed an association called the Anti-Barren Island League, and have visited the State Board of Health, several Governors, and the Boards of Health of Greater New York, and this was the result.”
